WORKFORCE TRAINING SCHOLARSHIP

Provides financial assistance to Chautauqua County residents pursuing job training or certification outside of higher educational degree pathway. Examples include, home health aide, phlebotomist, CNA, EMT, CDL, electrician, plumbing, carpentry, etc.)

Online applications are accepted on a rolling basis and awarded at the end of each month.

JNP/CEO SCHOLARSHIP

Awarded to graduating JHS seniors and City of Jamestown residents attending Jamestown Community College or Jamestown Business College.

Online applications are due April 1, 2023.

MUSIC SCHOLARSHIPS

K-11 Students-Awarded for private music lessons and camp.

High School Seniors and College Students - Awarded for higher education. *Live audition required!*

Applications are due May 1st
