FOUNDATION AID INCREASE PLAN 2022-2023

The 2022-2023 enacted State Budget included language stating that, for the 2022-2023 school year, each school district receiving a Foundation Aid increase of more than 10% or \$10 million must post a plan for how the additional funds will be used to the District Website before July 1st.

Below is a summary of the planned use of the \$1,491,668 increase in Foundation Aid as included in the Falconer Central School District 2022-2023 adopted budget.

Reducing Class Sizes - \$227,778.00

The District is using the increase of Foundation Aid to maintain classroom sizes. This will allow for continuing classrooms with smaller class sizes than the maximum number of students per classroom.
